VALECHE SIGNS NO CLIMATE TAX PLEDGE

WANTS CLIMATE CHANGE POLICIES REVENUE NEUTRAL

Palm Beach Gardens, Florida—Hal Valeche, Republican Candidate for Florida's 16th Congressional District, is the first candidate to sign the Americans for Prosperity's "No Climate Tax Pledge." The pledge declares, "that climate change legislation will not be used to fund a dramatic expansion in the size and scope of government."

By signing this pledge, Hal Valeche "pledge[d] to the taxpayers of the state of Florida and to the American people that [he] will oppose any legislation relating to climate change that includes a net increase in federal revenues."

Hal Valeche has already signed the Americans for Tax Reform Pledge not to raise taxes and both the Citizens Against Government Waste and Freedom Works Earmark Pledges not to request earmarks. Signing the Americans for Prosperity pledge continues to show Hal's commitment to lower taxes and limited government.
